

Would my student be able to leave during holidays or celebrations?

Students can leave for the Fourth of July holiday with permission from staff.

Will my student be able to bring their car on campus?

Bridge students can bring their car on campus if they are 18 during the program.

Does the program cover all meals?

All meals will be covered throughout the duration of the program. If a student decided to spend their own money on other food options offered on campus or on excursions they have the option to do so as well.

How does the program accommodate students with IEPs or special accommodations?

All paperwork for accommodations will need to be turned in prior to the beginning of the program. Based on these needs, we will plan accordingly with the Accessibility Resource Center.

Do the participants have to share rooms?

Students have the option of sharing a room or living in a single room.

Are the participants going to have access to all buildings?

While the students will have a student ID card, they will not have access to any of the buildings. They would need a staff member to open up all buildings at all times.

What happens if my student gets sick during the program?

All medications will need to be given to staff on move in day. Staff will administer medications with parent approval and/or documentation in the case of an emergency or sickness and will be called prior to.

How are the students going to receive a grade at the end of the program?

Participants will receive 6 college credit hours that

will count towards their course work/GPA at Guilford College and or transfer credit elsewhere.

Are the participants going to have access to the schedule?

Every Sunday, the schedule will be posted for the students to see the itinerary for the whole week. The schedule will include all curriculum work and extra-curricular activities.

Will there be staff staying with the students?

Yes, staff members will be living in the same halls with the participants throughout the duration of the program. Guilford College also has Public Safety on call throughout all hours.
